Anthony Battaglini, 79 a lifelong resident of West Aliquippa passed away with his family by his side on January 12, 2025.

He was born May 13, 1945, West Aliquippa and is the son of the late Guiseppe Bataglino and Helen (Marchionda) Marsolo. He was a member of Aliquippa Council from 1998-2002. Anthony was proudly appointed as Acting Mayor in 2003. He was elected Mayor of his cherished town from January 5, 2004, serving the residents of Aliquippa until 2011.

Anthony was a hard worker. He worked several jobs throughout his life beginning with his work at Liuna Local 833, where he had over 40 years of

service . He also worked at the LTV Steel works Tin Mill in Aliquippa where he was a member the Steelworkers, Local 1211. Anthony later worked for the Aliquippa School District as the director of transportation until his retirement. In addition to the previous positions he worked, Anthony was also the owner and operator of Battaglini's Lounge and several other businesses within the community over the years.

Anthony was immensely devoted to his family and was a wonderful husband, father and grandfather.
