With heavy hearts on December 14, 2019 we unexpectedly said goodbye to our beloved father and grandfather, Anthony L. Mastrofrancesco.

Tony was born November 6, 1940 in Aliquippa and was the son of the late Luigi and Angelina (Corsi) Mastrofrancesco. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife of 52 years Carol (DiBenedetto)

Mastrofrancesco, two brothers and sisters-in-law: Mario and Victoria Mastrofrancesco and Renato and Lydia Mastrofrancesco.

Tony was a faithful, devoted member of St. Titus Roman Catholic Church where he served as a Eucharistic Minister. When there was a function at the church hall one would find Tony collecting money for fish fries and spaghetti dinners or bar tending with his dear friend Gigi Rossi. Tony also served as President for St. Titus Holy Name Society and was a founding member of the San Cataldo Organization. He took great pride in also assisting with other clubs and organizations.

Tony worked two jobs to provide for his family. In 1974 Tony proudly opened Anthony Mastrofrancesco Funeral Home where he faithfully worked to serve families in their time of loss until his health declined. He also retired from the Beaver County Jail in 2004 after 40 years of service.

Surviving Tony is a son: Anthony (Angela) Mastrofrancesco, a daughter, Lesa Mastrofrancesco and Darin Smoot who Tony loved liked a son. Three grandsons, Matthew, Jacob and Lucas of whom their Pap was extremely

proud.
