Dominic J. Ross of Charlotte, NC, formerly of Aliquippa, passed away peacefully the morning of February 27, 2022. He was born September 26, 1931 in Aliquippa, PA, and was the son of the late Joseph and Nellie (Stala) Ross. 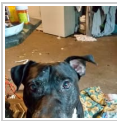
