



John Joseph Schreiber

October 10, 1930 - April 22, 2015

John Joseph Schreiber, a loving husband and father, passed into eternal life at Villa St. Joseph in Baden, on Wednesday, April 22, 2015. He was 84. Born in Philadelphia, PA on October 10, 1930, John was the second child of Paul Schreiber and Elizabeth (Hartdegen) Schreiber. He graduated from St. Joseph's Preparatory School in 1948 and Gettysburg College in 1954, where he excelled in baseball and was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. After service in the U.S. Air Force, he married Helen Frances Cook, an educator from Kempton, Maryland, on June 21, 1958. They had four children: John Terrence Schreiber (m. Catherine Kennelly), Pleasant Hill, CA; Kristin Mary (Schreiber) Schmitt, Coraopolis, PA; Maura Anne (Schreiber) Schreiner (m. John Schreiner), Burnt Hills, NY; Colette Mary Schreiber, Aliquippa, PA. He retired in 1988 from the U.S. Department of Energy, after directing the Shippingport Atomic Power Station decommissioning project to completion. A lifelong golf enthusiast, he took special pride in his local golf league, whose members' friendship he enjoyed for many years. He was also a skilled woodworker and dedicated lay minister in his faith community at St. Frances Cabrini parish. John is survived by Helen and their four children. In addition, he is survived by his sister, Elizabeth (Schreiber) Durban, his two grandchildren, Jessica and Jared Schreiner, and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by two brothers, Paul Schreiber of Philadelphia, PA and Joseph Schreiber of Warminster, PA.
